

## Other Summer Opportunities

### PRESBYTERIAN YOUTH TRIENNIUM .....July 20-24, 2010



This is a gathering of youth and adults from across the U.S. and the world held at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana. Eligibility begins with youth entering high school. Youth delegates can not be more than 19 years old on July 20, 2010. Adult advisors must be at least 21 years old on July 20, 2010. Participants must register with and travel with the Presbytery of Des Moines' delegation. Bus transportation will be arranged. Delegations must include one adult for every 10 young people, of the same gender. Check-in is from 1-6 p.m., July 20. Triennium begins with dinner on the 20<sup>th</sup> and ends with worship the 24<sup>th</sup>.

This year's theme is "For Such A Time As This" (Esther 4:14). Cost for the event is \$409.00 per person (which includes secondary insurance coverage, housing, meals, conference T-shirt and all programming), but does not include the cost of transportation. The Presbytery of Des Moines plans to scholarship all or part of the transportation costs. 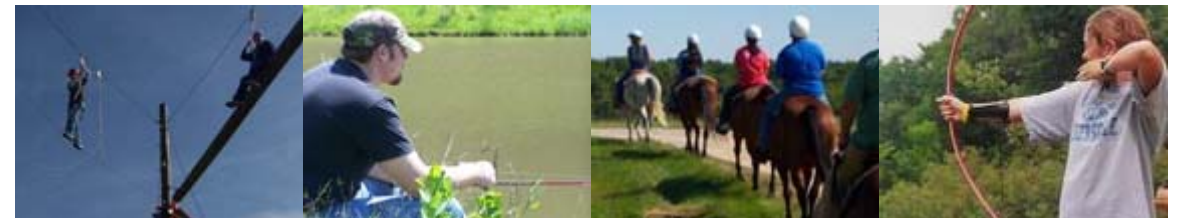
